

DONOR'S QUICK CHECKLIST

Before driving a vehicle to Ukraine as humanitarian aid, make sure you have completed the following steps:

Vehicle preparation

- Vehicle has a valid **MOT**
- UK road tax** has been paid
- Insurance covers driving in the EU**
- You have the **original V5C registration document**

Customs documentation

- A Ukrainian **charitable organisation has created a Customs Declaration** for the vehicle
- You have received the **PDF copy of the Customs Declaration**
- You have **printed one copy** to present at the Ukrainian border

Vehicle information provided to the Ukrainian charity

- Driver's **surname, name and passport number**
- Vehicle **make and model**
- Registration number**
- VIN number**
- Engine capacity and fuel type**
- Year of manufacture**
- Vehicle weight (Mass in Service)**
- Name and address of the donor**

Before travelling

- Confirm **where you will meet the Ukrainian charity** after crossing the border
- Arrange **signing of the Act of Transfer** upon arrival

At the Ukrainian border

- Present the **Customs Declaration**
- Present the **V5C registration document**
- Ensure both documents receive **customs stamps**

After entering Ukraine

- Meet the Ukrainian charity that issued the declaration
- Sign the Act of Transfer** to transfer ownership of the vehicle

✔ After these steps are complete, your vehicle can be legally transferred to Ukrainian soldiers and registered in Ukraine.
